Please READ carefully the **CRITERIA** and **INSTRUCTIONS** below before completing, signing and submitting the application form. Failure to follow the instructions hereunder may result in the application being disqualified.

CRITERIA

1. The bursary is only available South African Citizens.
2. The bursary is only available to persons who are **currently** employed in the Mining and Minerals Sector.
3. Preference in the awarding of the bursary will be given to historically disadvantaged applicants based on a weighting system based on the following criteria: gender, disability, appropriateness of the qualification in relation to the Mining and Mineral Sector as well as academic performance.
4. The bursary is only available to applicants who want to pursue their studies at a South African university and university of technology. Applications to study at a private institution will not be considered.
5. The awarding of the bursary is at the sole discretion of the MQA and communication will only be entered into with the pre-selected candidates. The MQA also reserves the right not to award a bursary to any pre-selected candidate(s).
6. Successful candidates will be required to enter into a bursary contractual agreement signed between the candidate and the MQA.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure that this form is completed in full, and in **BLOCK LETTERS**. An application form which is incomplete, and submitted without all the required supporting documents, will be disqualified.
2. The application form must be submitted **TOGETHER** with all the required supporting documents.

4. Late / faxed / e-mailed application forms will **NOT** be considered.
